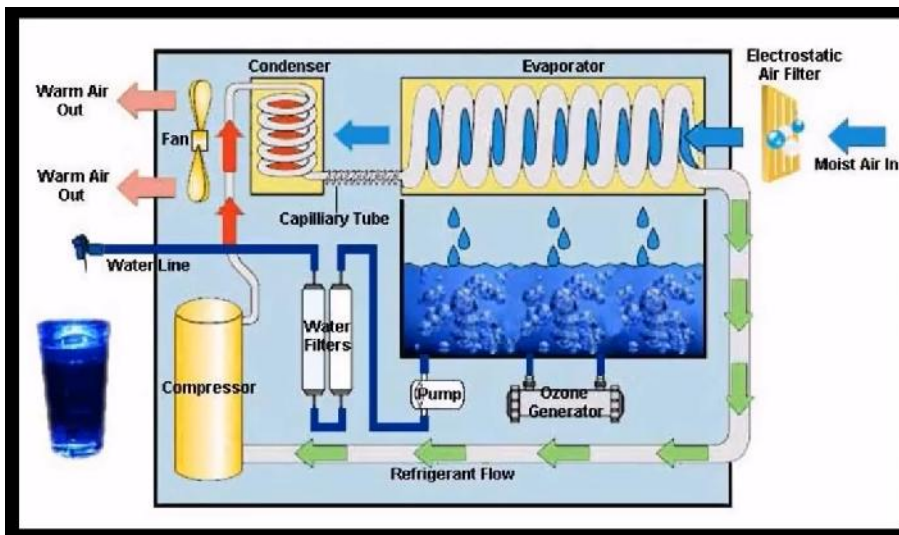
GTU is a grassroots organization established to accomplish the following Missions:
